01) Family Counseling Centre

The Indian Family was traditionally and extended family the earning and non earning member lived together in mutual support and provided shelter and substances to the young and old members of the family. However the traditional family system is breaking down due to many problems.

The stress and strain of modern life is resulting in the failure of several marriages due to various reasons. The main problems are domestic violence, alcoholisms, maladjustment of partner, dowry demand. Interferences of in-lows due to these problems the family support and marriage counseling services are very much essential at this need of the hours.

With the assistant of central social Welfare board (Central Govt. Board) started the program of family counseling centre in response to the rising trend of domestic violence and dowry problem.

Through the counseling centre addresses a genuine need of society. So fulfilling the need of the families in the district organization run the centre from 2001.

As experience form last 20 years we feel to need work on pre marriage counseling sessions in five collages of city arrange counseling sessions in NSS and NCC camps of collages.

To counseling the families and individual through the centre also organized so many awareness generation program on various issue like campaign of Female feticide, Legal awareness in rural area. Poster exhibition on the various issues, calibration of World Women day, National Balika din.

2) Special Cell for Women and Children

The Special cell for Women and Children is joint program of the department of Women and child development, Home department, (police) and the Adhar Bahuddeshiya Sanstha, Amalner, Dist-Jalgaon. [NGO]) the location of the cell in the police superintendent office in Jalgaon to work on the issue of violence against women and children. The special cell undertakes its work within the Indian constitution and work toward ensuring that women are recognized as individual with equal rights and opportunity in society. Including the opportunity to leave peaceful violence free life.

The special cell located within the police system to work with the understanding that violence against women is the crime against both her and society. Major rule of the cell is to prevent protect and counter it.

Appoint suitable and trained social workers for intervention, they are trained and orient for the work on violence against women as a person with right and entitlement and enable her to gain access to these though the problem solving process. She is empowered through the problem solving process which validates her experience.

4)TARGETTED INTERVENTION FOR CSW (Prevantion for HIV/AIDS)

SWAADHAR

To halt and reverse the prevalence of HIV among the brothel and non brothel based female Sex Worker (FSW) population and to provide quality health services for their sexual health needs in six block of Jalgaon district.

Aadhar initiated the programme on STD/HIV/AIDs with the support of Maharashtra state AIDs control society since 2003 the programme focus on prevention and control of STI HIV/AIDs incidences among Brothel, on brothel and home base female Sex worker form(Amalner ,Chopda,Parola,Dharangaon and Pechora).

Block of Jalgaon district. In above 600 hundred FSWs covering the project.

In Nov-13 (2013-14) project celebrated completion of 10 years of prject, community member and Adhar team organised the program for celebrating the annivercry. Chief judge of Amalner court, DYSP Amalner Ms. Anita patil, Medical officer Dr. ApprnaMutte, Dr. Anjali Chavan, ICTC counselor are invited as a guest for program.

The project is implementing through the active participant of target community.10 peer educator which are from community work in the project PE and FSW could develop self confidence and self image and as there networking got strengthen they started Community base organization (CBOs) name Hardasi Swadhar Vikas Mahila Sanstha (HSMVS).

Goal of the Project

- Registration (enrollment in the project)
- Behaviuor change communication session
- Focus group discussion
- Counseling for HIV -STI and other personal discus. (Testing each twice in a year of HIV.Regularcheck up quarterly of each FSW)
- Regular check up, Treatment and prevention care for STI (Sexually transmitted disease)
- Free distribution and social marketing condom distribution.
- Care and support services for the women living with HIV.

05) Link Worker Scheme

Reduce the spread of HIV and incidence of STI in rural area of Jalgaon district of Maha State through the networking with existing Govt. Health establishes system. With the help of village community implement the Link Worker Scheme in 100 villages of Jalgoan Districts.

It is an evidence of 57% of HIV population is from rural area. With low literacy level and low level of awareness of HIV/AIDs making it is one of the most challenging health problems ever faced by the country 90% of HIV transmission in India is related to unprotected sexual intercourse. The core high risk group of individuals are most at risk female sex worker, MSM, Injective drug users. The epidemic will not be controlled but the positive implication is that of HIV prevention is successful among this HRGs the epidemic will be substantially curtailed.

Jalgaon is one of the High prevalence district of HIV in Maharashtra. There are around 3500 to 4000 FSWs exiting in Jalgaon district. Jalgaon district have a border of state Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat is easily connected with railway and have a big industrial area so incoming and outgoing both migration of single male is high.

Aadhar Sanstha working in rural community mobilization (Link Worker Scheme) since March 2010 with the Support of National AIDs Control organization (NACO), Maharashtra State AIDs control Society (MSACS) and Avert Society, Mumbai under the project Aadhar covering 100 vulnerable villages form. Jalgaon district of Maharashtra State.



Objective

- Reach out the vulnerable Young People and HRGs with information knowledge and skills on HIV and STI prevention and risk reduction.
- Create and enabling and environment for PLHIVs and their families by reducing stigma and discrimination.
- PLHIVs promote increase and consistent use of condom.
- Counseling services for prevention and care support to HIV.
- Strengthening Village community for sustainability.

Target Group

HRGs-Female sex worker (FSW), Man having sex with man (MSM)

Vulnerable -Vul.Man and Women- Trucker, Cleaners, Clint of partner of FSW, person living with HIV/Aids, Youth, Migrant and single women.
